Tuesday, August 10, 2021

Pursuant to the law, the Atchison County Commission Board met in Regular Session at 1:00 PM at the Emergency Operations Center, 10443 US Hwy 59 Atchison, KS. A link to the meeting was made available to the public prior to the meeting. In addition, public attendance was available for the Commission meeting at the Emergency Operations Center, 10443 US Hwy 59 Atchison. Chairman Jack Bower called the meeting to order with Commissioner Eric Noll, Commissioner Casey Quinn and County Counselor Patrick Henderson present for the meeting. Deputy County Election Officer Kalee Vanderweide recorded the minutes

The Board recited the pledge of allegiance to start the meeting.

*Public Comment

There were no public comments.

*Reading and Approval of Minutes:

Minutes of the August 3, 2021 meeting were reviewed with one correction noted; to change Northeast Kansas meeting on August 19th to Northeast Kansas Environmental Services. Commissioner Noll made the motion to approve the minutes as amended. Commissioner Quinn seconded the motion. Chairman Bower called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

*New Business Before the Board:

Trevor Tutt, Mo-Kan Regional appeared before the Board via Zoom to talk to the Board about a Rural Preservation Grant. The County previously applied for a Rural Preservation Grant and was awarded \$9,450.00 for the repairs of the North and East porticos. Commissioner Quinn made a motion to allow the Chairman to sign the agreements needed to administer the grants. Commissioner Noll seconded the motion. Chairman Bower called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

Justin Pregont, appeared before the Board to discussion of a potential Industrial Revenue Bond for the Central School Apartment project.
