Tuesday, August 24, 2021

Pursuant to the law, the Atchison County Commission Board met in Regular Session at 1:00 PM at the Emergency Operations Center, 10443 US Hwy 59 Atchison, KS. A link to the meeting was made available to the public prior to the meeting. In addition, public attendance was available for the Commission meeting at the Emergency Operations Center, 10443 US Hwy 59 Atchison. Chairman Jack Bower called the meeting to order with Commissioner Eric Noll, Commissioner Casey Quinn and County Counselor Patrick Henderson present for the meeting. Deputy County Election Officer Kalee Vanderweide recorded the minutes

The Board recited the pledge of allegiance to start the meeting.

***Public Comment**

Mary Baker presented a survey she conducted via social media. Mrs. Baker had nine questions on this survey for the accessibility of information due to Covid numbers and how others perceive the current local situation. Mrs. Baker volunteered to help post updates of Atchison County Covid numbers.

***Reading and Approval of Minutes:**

Minutes of the August 17, 2021 meeting were reviewed with no corrections noted. Commissioner Noll made the motion to approve the minutes as amended. Commissioner Quinn seconded the motion. Chairman Bower called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

Minutes of the August 18, 2021 special meeting were reviewed with no corrections noted. Commissioner Noll made the motion to approve the minutes as amended. Commissioner Quinn seconded the motion. Chairman Bower called for a vote. The motion passed 2-0, with Chairman Bower abstaining.

***Commissioner Comments and Committee Reports**

Commissioner Noll stated the Pfizer Covid vaccine has now been approved by the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA). Commissioner Noll stated the Moderna Covid vaccine should be approved by the FDA soon.

Commissioner Quinn stated that she had a meeting with Mark Hastings, Anew Healthcare, to discuss Atchison Senior Village and how they would be able to help.

Commissioner Quinn stated she had a Joint Communication Board Meeting on Wednesday, August 18, 2021.

Commissioner Quinn stated she attended the Fair Board Meeting on Wednesday, August 18, 2021.

Commissioner Quinn stated she had an all staff meeting at Atchison Senior Village on Thursday, August 19, 2021.

Commissioner Quinn stated she volunteered with Project Atchison at the Fox Theatre on Friday, August 20, 2021, to help Benedictine College students attend to watch Footsteps and then headed out into Atchison for a cleanup day.

***New Business Before the Board:**

Tracy Shafton, Gilmore Bell, appeared before the Board to present a Resolution for Benedictine College Revenue Bonds.

Chairman Bower declared that a quorum was present. There was presented a Resolution entitled:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ATCHISON COUNTY, KANSAS, TO ISSUE ITS EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES REVENUE BONDS (BENEDICTINE COLLEGE PROJECT), SERIES 2021 FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING A PROJECT OF BENEDICTINE COLLEGE; AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF CERTAIN DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE ISSUANCE OF THE BONDS AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN OTHER ACTIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE ISSUANCE OF SAID BONDS.

Commissioner Quinn moved that the Resolution be adopted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Noll. Chairman Bower called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0. Chairman Bower declared the Resolution duly adopted and the Resolution was then duly numbered Resolution No. 2021-1485 and was signed by the Commissioners and attested by the Deputy County Clerk.

Shelly Nelson, Community Corrections Supervisor, appeared before the Board to get approval on her FY2022 Carryover Reimbursement Plans of \$205,697.74 on the Adult side and \$46,302.53 on the Juvenile side. This has to be budgeted. Commissioner Noll made a motion to allow the Chairman to sign the FY2022 Carryover Reimbursement Plans for the Adult and Juvenile sides. Commissioner Quinn seconded the motion. Chairman Bower called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

Wes Lanter, Emergency Management/IT Director, appeared before the Board with a purchase order to Converge One, for two PowerEdge R440 Server, Virtual Host and the installation, programming, mitigation, in the amount of \$17,708.08. Commissioner Quinn made a motion to approve the purchase order to Converge One, in the amount of \$17,708.08. Commissioner Noll seconded the motion. Chairman Bower called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

Commissioner Quinn made a motion to approve a purchase order to the Atchison Chamber of Commerce for 2021 Chamber dues, in the amount of \$225.00. Commissioner Noll seconded the motion. Chairman Bower called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

Chairman Bower opened the Revenue Neutral Rate (RNR) hearing. Hearing no comment, the RNR hearing was closed. Chairman Bower opened the 2022 Budget hearing. Hearing no comment, the 2022 Budget hearing was closed. Commissioner Quinn made a motion to approve the 2022 Budget. Commissioner Noll seconded the motion. Chairman Bower called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

***County Counselor Updates:**

There were no counselor updates.

***Public Comment:**

Bills were presented to be signed.

Add, abate, escapes for real estate and personal property taxes were presented to be approved.

Commissioner Quinn made the motion to adjourn at 1:32 pm. Commissioner Noll seconded the motion. Chairman Bower called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.
