

RESOLUTION NO. 1030

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS
OF THE COUNTY THE PROPOSITION OF LEVYING A ONE
PERCENT (1%) RETAILER'S SALES TAX IN THE COUNTY
OF ATCHISON

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 12-187 et seq., as amended, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of the county to submit to the qualified electors of the county the question of levying a retailer's sales tax, such tax to be collected by the State Department of Revenue with the revenue therefrom returned and distributed as provided by law within this county, and




WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that additional revenue is needed by the County and Cities to provide an adequate level of public services, that additional revenue is needed to improve and maintain the public roads, and streets and other public facilities, that property tax increases should be avoided if possible, that additional revenue is needed to develop and construct industrial park facilities to facilitate economic growth, and that the voters should be given a choice as to the method used to finance public services.

NOW, THEREFORE: BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ATCHISON COUNTY KANSAS:


A special question election shall be held in the manner prescribed by law on the 6th day of November, 1984 for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of Atchison County, the question of levying a countywide retailers' sales tax in Atchison County, Kansas, in the amount of one percent (1%), such tax to take effect on the 1st day of January, 1985 if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

This resolution shall take effect on publication in the official county newspaper.

ADOPTED, this 5th day of September, 1984, by the Board of County Commissioners, Atchison County, Kansas.
