

ATCHISON COUNTY, KANSAS
RESOLUTION NO. 2013-1381

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ATCHISON COUNTY, KANSAS on this 3rd day of December, 2013 by their authority for the promotion of health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of Atchison County, Kansas hereby establishes users rates ("Tipping Fees" hereinafter) at the Atchison County Transfer Station.

WHEREAS, The COUNTY is engaged in the business of operating a non-hazardous and hazardous waste solid waste transfer station located at 8575 Neosho Road, Atchison KS ("Transfer Station") and final disposal of such waste and recyclables; and

WHEREAS, Atchison County passed resolution 2013-1375, on October 22nd, 2013. Said resolution being an Interlocal Agreement between the County, and the Cities of Atchison, Effingham, Huron, Lancaster, and Muscotah, in regards to the Atchison County Retailers Sales Tax. Per the Resolution, all parties agree to commit a defined sum of the collected Sales Tax to the funding of the Atchison County Joint Communications and Solid Waste Departments. In addition to the Sales Tax commitments, the resolution requires the County to establish a Tipping Fee, as supplemental revenue for the operation of the Atchison County Transfer Station.

NOW THEREFORE, The Transfer Station Tipping Fee shall apply as follows:

\$ 17.50 per Half Ton (1,000 lbs.) of, or in any combination of, Municipal Solid Waste (MSW), Co-mingled Recyclables, and/or Construction and Demolition Debris (C&D).

This rate shall apply to Private Businesses that bring the aforementioned types of waste and exceeds the half ton limit, either in a single load.

This rate shall apply to any Atchison County Resident bringing any of the aforementioned types of waste and exceeds the half ton limit at one time.

\$ 12.50 per Ton (2,000 lbs.) of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) or Co-Mingled Recyclables collected and transported by the City of Atchison, Public Works Department, Solid Waste Division, to the Transfer Station.

\$ 65.00 per Ton (2,000lbs.) of Out-of- County Construction and Demolition Debris (C&D) brought to the Transfer Station.

\$ 50.00 per Ton (2,000 lbs.) of Out-of-County Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) or Comingled Recycling brought to the Transfer Station.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Tonnage shall be determined on an aggregate basis. The Solid Waste Manager shall determine whose aggregated usage warrants applicable charges.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, ALL vehicles bringing any type of waste to be disposed of at the Transfer Station, will be required to be weighed on the roadside scale located on the east side of Neosho Rd. Vehicles that do not meet the aforementioned rate conditions, will NOT be charged a tipping fee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Construction and Demolition (C&D) that is a product of any City mandated demolition, pursuant to the respective city's police powers, that tonnage will not be assessed a tipping fee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Waste types such as brush and tree limbs, compost, or Household Hazardous Waste (HHW), or used tires (tire monofil only) will not be charged a Tipping Fee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the above provisions are hereby adopted on the day and year first written by the Board of County Commissioners of Atchison County, Kansas and this Resolution shall go into force and become effective upon publication. The new Tipping Fee rates will go into effect starting January 1, 2014.


