## **Tuesday, July 5, 2022**

Pursuant to the law, the Atchison County Commission Board met in Regular Session at 1:00 PM at the Atchison County Courthouse, Lower Level, 423 N 5<sup>th</sup> St., Atchison, KS. A link to the meeting was made available to the public prior to the meeting. In addition, public attendance was available for the Commission meeting at the Atchison County Courthouse, Lower Level, 423 N 5<sup>th</sup> St., Atchison, KS. Vice-Chairwoman Casey Quinn called the meeting to order with Commissioner Jack Bower, Chairman Eric Noll and County Counselor Patrick Henderson present for the meeting. Kalee Vanderweide, Deputy County Election Officer, recorded the minutes.

The Board recited the pledge of allegiance to start the meeting.

### **\*Reading and Approval of Minutes:**

Minutes of the June 28, 2022 meeting were reviewed with no corrections noted. Commissioner Bower made the motion to approve the minutes as presented. Commissioner Noll seconded the motion. Vice-Chairwoman Quinn called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

### **\*Commissioner Comments and Committee Reports**

Commissioner Noll stated he had Covid-19 last week and that is why he is remote for the meeting.

### **\*New Business Before the Board:**

Wes Lanter, Emergency Management/IT Director, appeared before the Board via Zoom with the CodeRed Policy approval. Commissioner Bower made a motion to approve the CodeRed Policy as presented. Commissioner Noll seconded the motion. Vice-Chairwoman Quinn called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

Director Lanter presented a purchase order to Great American Financial, for Lenovo ThinkSystem Lease Purchase Buyout; which includes: 2 Lenovo Servers, 1 SAN Data Array, 1 NAS Storage Device VEEam Backup Bundle, Vmware essentials Plus Licenses Windows Server and SQL Licenses, in the amount of \$22,968.51. Commissioner Bower made a motion to approve the purchase order to Great American Financial, in the amount of \$22,968.51. Commissioner Noll seconded the motion. Vice-Chairwoman Quinn called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

Bills were presented to be signed.
