**Tuesday, August 16, 2022**

Pursuant to the law, the Atchison County Commission Board met in Regular Session at 1:00 PM at the Atchison County Courthouse, Lower Level, 423 N 5<sup>th</sup> St., Atchison, KS. A link to the meeting was made available to the public prior to the meeting. In addition, public attendance was available for the Commission meeting at the Atchison County Courthouse, Lower Level, 423 N 5<sup>th</sup> St., Atchison, KS. Chairman Eric Noll, called the meeting to order Commission Casey Quinn, Commissioner Jack Bower, and County Counselor Patrick Henderson present for the meeting. Kalee Vanderweide, Deputy County Election Officer recorded the minutes.

The Board recited the pledge of allegiance to start the meeting.

**\*Reading and Approval of Minutes:**

Minutes of the August 8, 2022 meeting were reviewed with no corrections noted. Commissioner Bower made the motion to approve the minutes as presented. Commissioner Quinn seconded the motion. Chairman Noll called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

**\*Commissioner Comments and Committee Reports**

Commissioner Quinn stated that the deadline to submit photography for the Atchison County website redesign is Friday, August 19, 2022. All photography can be sent to Wesley Lanter at [wlanter@atcoks.org](mailto:wlanter@atcoks.org).

Commissioner Quinn stated that further discussion was held on the countywide fiber. Commissioner Quinn has a phone call in to Kansas Farm Bureau to try and obtain data; that had been previously gathered, for the internet needs in our county. Commissioner Quinn obtained the corporate phone number for Century Link, to try and get more information on the boxes left in the county with no follow up.

**\*New Business Before the Board:**

Commissioner Bower made a motion to approve a purchase order, against the County Attorney's Capital Outlay budget, for conference room supplies, in the amount of \$1,219.12. Commissioner Quinn seconded the motion. Chairman Noll called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

Wesley Lanter, Emergency Management/IT Director, appeared before the board via the Zoom platform, with a purchase order to Road Safe Traffic Systems for a Buff-7390LCDG-01 TouScreen Graph LCD, in the amount of \$3,350.75. Commissioner Quinn made a motion to approve the purchase order to Road Safe Traffic Systems, in the amount of \$3,350.75. Commissioner Bower seconded the motion. Chairman Noll called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

Joe Snyder, Road & Bridge Superintendent, presented a purchase order to Terracon Consultants, Inc., for Geotechnical Engineering Services for Sherman Road, in the amount of \$11,500.00. Commissioner Quinn made a motion to approve the purchase order to Terracon Consultants, Inc., in the amount of \$11,500.00. Commissioner Bower seconded the motion. Chairman Noll called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

Commissioner Bower made a motion to approve a purchase order to Bottorff Construction, for parking lot paving improvements at Atchison Senior Village, in the amount of \$2,948.00. Commissioner Quinn seconded the motion. Chairman Noll called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

Commissioner Bower made a motion to approve a purchase order to The Home Depot Pro Institutional, for a Hydropower Ultra LG Kit 39' Powerwasher, in the amount of \$3,115.38. Commissioner Quinn seconded the motion. Chairman Noll called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

Commissioner Quinn presented an invoice from ServPro of Leavenworth to do restoration at the Atchison Senior Village, in the amount of \$3,944.89. Commissioner Bower made a motion to accept the invoice to ServPro of Leavenworth, in the amount of \$3,944.89. Chairman Noll seconded the motion. Chairman Noll called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.

**\*County Counselor Updates:**

Patrick Henderson, County Counselor stated there is a hearing on August 18, 2022, on the tax sale, for granting judgement on all the properties.

**\*Public Comment:**

There were no public comments.

Bills were presented to be signed.

Commissioner Bower made the motion to adjourn at 1:10 pm. Commissioner Quinn seconded the motion. Chairman Noll called for a vote, all voted aye. The motion passed 3-0.
