

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-1454

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO BUILD OR REPAIR EXISTING BRIDGES IN THE COUNTY UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF K.S.A. 68-1103; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS TO PAY THE COSTS THEREOF (2019 BRIDGE PROJECTS).

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 68-1103, as amended (the “Act”) provides, in part, that the governing body (the “Board”) of Atchison County, Kansas (the “County”) may determine, by resolution, that it is necessary to build or repair any road, bridge or culvert to meet the demands of present day traffic, and to issue general obligation bonds of the County to pay the costs thereof, if sufficient funds are not available in the County treasury; and

WHEREAS, the Board hereby finds and determines that certain existing bridges in the County need to be built or repaired, that sufficient funds therefor are not available and general obligation bonds of the County should be issued to pay the costs of building or repairing such bridges under the authority of the Act.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ATCHISON COUNTY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Project Authorization. It is hereby determined that one or more of the following bridge projects, as determined by the Board, be built or repaired in accordance with plans and specifications developed or approved by Atchison County Engineer (collectively the “Projects”):

11.9-F.3	Bridge on Graham Road between 246th Road and 150th Road	\$ 66,821
H.1-13.4	3.4 miles east of Effingham	83,849
C.0-16.8	Bridge on 222nd Road immediately east of U.S. 59 Highway	211,289
A.0-23.7	Bridge on 206th Road near Rawlins Road	143,635
270	Bridge on 222nd Road immediately east of U.S. 59 Highway	215,602
520	Bridge on 310th Road near Pratt Road	151,082


SECTION 2. Financing Authority. The costs of the Projects, plus associated financing costs, shall be paid by the issuance of general obligation bonds (the “Bonds”) of the County under the authority of the Act.

SECTION 3. Reimbursement Authority. The Bonds authorized and issued pursuant to this Resolution may be used to reimburse Projects expenditures made on or after the date which is 60 days before the date of this Resolution, pursuant to Treasury Regulation 1.150-2.


SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.


