

RESOLUTION NO. 1129

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO ENLARGE, REMODEL, REPAIR, EQUIP AND FURNISH THE ATCHISON SENIOR VILLAGE OWNED AND OPERATED BY ATCHISON COUNTY, KANSAS; TO AUTHORIZE AN ANNUAL TAX LEVY NOT TO EXCEED 2 MILLS UPON THE TAXABLE TANGIBLE PROPERTY IN THE COUNTY TO PAY THE COST THEREOF; AND PROVIDING FOR THE GIVING OF NOTICE OF SAID INTENTION, ALL PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 19-2106b

WHEREAS, Atchison County, Kansas (the "County"), has established a county home for the aged (the "Atchison Senior Village") under the authority of K.S.A. 19-2106b; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 19-2106b (the "Act") the Board of County Commissioners of the County is authorized to provide for the enlargement of or addition to the home previously established and for equipping, repairing, remodeling, or furnishing of such home, enlargement, or addition; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that it is necessary and desirable to raise \$1,400,000.00 for the purpose of enlarging, remodeling, repairing, equipping and furnishing the Atchison Senior Village and to establish the authority to levy an annual tax of not to exceed 2 mills upon the taxable tangible property of the County for the purpose of raising such funds;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ATCHISON COUNTY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. It is hereby deemed and declared to be necessary to establish the authority to levy an annual tax of not to exceed 2 mills on the taxable tangible property in the County for the purpose of enlarging, remodeling, repairing, equipping and furnishing the Atchison Senior Village (the "Improvements") at a cost not to exceed \$1,400,000.00.

SECTION 2. Before making the Improvements and establishing the authority to levy such taxes this resolution shall be published once each week for three consecutive weeks in the official newspaper of the County, and if within 30 days after the last publication of this resolution, there is filed with the County Clerk, a written petition requesting an election on the proposition, signed by not less than 10% of the electors of the County who voted for secretary of state at the last preceding general election, the Board of Commissioners shall submit the question of making the Improvement to the voters of the County at an election to be called for that purpose as provided by the Act. If no sufficient protest is filed with the County Clerk within the period of time hereinbefore stated, then the Board of County Commissioners of the County shall proceed to authorize the Improvements and shall have the authority to levy such taxes.
